

#258 Reving the Word: The Greatest Showman

{Purpose: To work out shame, guilt, condemnation, fear, unbelief}

Acts 28:25-27: “The Holy Spirit spoke the truth to your ancestors when he said through Isaiah the prophet: ‘Go to this people and say, you will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving. For this people’s heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise, they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them.’”

Seek Understanding Over Knowledge:

- Understanding brings together the mind and the brain.
- It marries the physical and spiritual.

“Pride keeps us seeing but not perceiving; hearing but not understanding. Want to lose some weight? Bow your heart. Don’t just read the Word of God→ let it read you.”

The Heart:

- Defined: Center of spiritual and physical life.
- It can be deceitful.
- Give your pain to God.

Integrated Life:

- Heart and mind working together inside the love of God. (No fear)
- “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, mind, soul, strength.”

“Love Him all. Take all the pain, all the hurt, all the disappointment to Him. Hand it over, under arrest. Surrender it.”

Perceiving:

- Seeing beyond what you see. Go higher. Look further into another realm.



- Kingdom perspective.

“Heart and mind working together, making decisions that will shift things. Shift light into darkness, hope into hopelessness, strength into weakness. Hearts alive. Hearts awake.”

Feel your Feelings in the Presence of God:

- If we don't, we will shut down our hearts.
- From your heart flows life or death.
- Everyone with a heartbeat is making a mark for good or for evil. Make your mark.

Calloused Heart:

- Meaning: Dull, to make thick, fat.
- Wherever we close down because of our pain, our hearts will grow calloused.
- The enemy wants you dull, lethargic.

“Do you want to be safe or free?”

The World Will Never Meet Your Needs:

- Needs were given to us by God for relationship.
- Come to Him.
- Let the Word of God lead you to Him.

Healthy Hearts. Healthy Bodies. Healthy Minds.

“Turn back. Come home. It's not too late...turn to Him and healing will come.”

“What makes us have a fat, dull, calloused heart? Too much YOU. Be with Him. Let Him have more of you. Awaken. Arise healthy heart, clear mind, open ears, sober minds.”

“You cannot believe what you see, but you can perceive something greater when your heart is not dull or calloused. Come higher. Say, ‘God, I don't have to know what you're doing, but could you give me a sense of how to bring this together with what you've said.’”

Turn and be healed.
