



# Creative Fundraising Ideas

- Approach your church about investing in you. Tell people! You will be surprised how they want to come alongside you and support you.
- Create a donation page on [firstgiving.com](https://firstgiving.com) or [gofundme.com](https://gofundme.com) where people can donate securely online.
- Let your family/friends know you want money for your birthday/Christmas to invest in what God is calling you to!
- What creative skills do you have? Can you bake, sew, take photographs, hand-letter, create artwork, make jewelry? Don't forget to tell people WHY you are creating & selling, and always think about upcoming holidays!
- Start saving monthly – plan ahead!
- Ask people to sponsor you using a poster/chart you make with different donation amounts ranging from \$1 all the way up to \$100. As people donate, you remove/cross off that number from your chart.
- Organize a Garage Sale. Ask for donations from friends to add to the sale.
- Go through your closets and sell more valuable items on Facebook Marketplace, Craigslist, ebay, or your personal Facebook & Instagram accounts.
- Organize a baked goods sale.
- Organize a spaghetti supper (or whatever food you might like) and ask for donations.
- Organize a pancake breakfast and charge or take donations.
- Organize a fitness class fundraiser/blacklight party/family fitness event and accept donations.
- Organize a car wash and accept donations.
- Organize a dog wash and accept donations (or a dog and car wash!)
- Organize a mother's day out.
- If you have an area of expertise, teach a class and ask others to partner with you.
- Raffle! Ask for donations of products from friends and create a theme basket to raffle.
- Offer coupons for services you can provide (house cleaning, babysitting, etc)
- T-shirt sales (use sites like [teespring.com](https://teespring.com))
- Organize a Lunch & Learn. Teach people about what you're planning to do and accept donations.
- Sell your extra shoes & clothes on Facebook marketplace - one of our instructors paid for her entire training this way.
- Ask a local Rev instructor to lead a class in your community to showcase what you want to bring to your community and ask for donations.
- Invite people to a viewing party! Participate in a RevWell TV workout together to show them what you desire to bring to your community and ask for donations.
